Following the museum tour members and guests took a short walk to Tubbys for lunch; where all were pleased with the food and service.



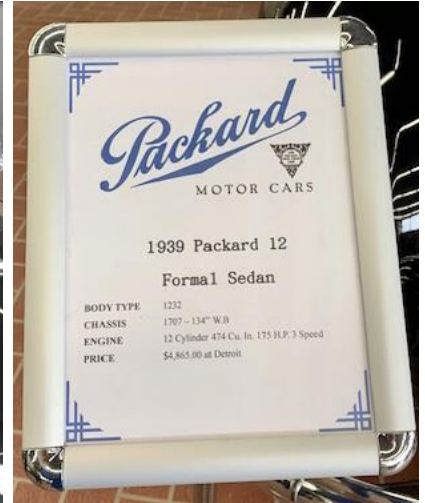


The museum is staffed by two full time very capable employees. In the rear of the facility is a full restoration shop with most tasks completed in-house.
