Important Message Regarding Insurance

Dear Chapter Directors, Division Directors, and Region Directors:

We are writing to advise you of a problem with the BCA's insurance coverage that has just recently come to light. Despite repeated representations by our insurance agent to the contrary, it now appears that the BCA's current insurance policy does not apply to our Chapters and Divisions, and therefore does not apply to your events and activities.

We are immediately taking steps to obtain a replacement policy that will provide the coverage we were led to believe we had (and that we've had in the past). At this time, we expect that this process will take a minimum of 10 days and may take several weeks. We will inform you as soon as a replacement policy has been obtained.

Due to the fact that we do not sponsor car shows, swap meets, etc., this is not a direct concern to us but something that we should pay attention to in the future.

This is a model of a 1930 Packard 734 Boat tail Speedster. It is a replica of one that Bill Harrah once owned. I thought I would do my own version because I was not fond of the original's color scheme.

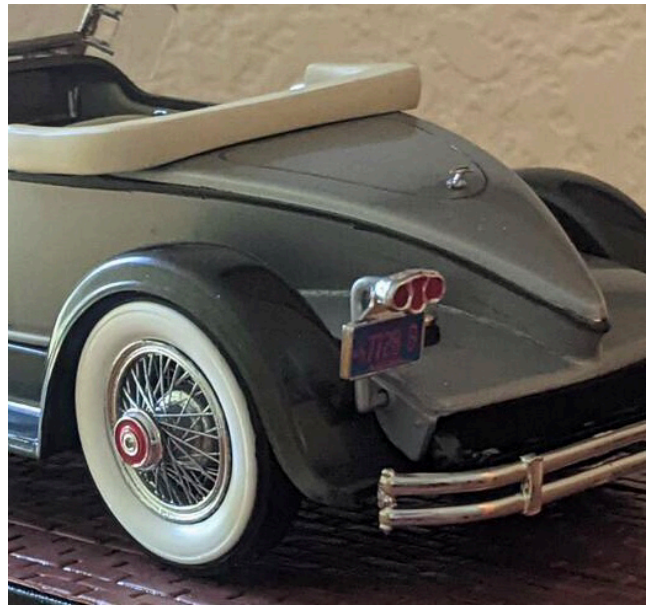
These high end cars were usually finished with a two tone paint scheme. I did mine in Linen Metallic (Porsche color) for the body and a color called Zeus Bronze for the fenders and pin striping. The paint job was probably the most difficult part of the build. It required lots of intricate masking with a thin foil to go around the curves and get a sharp edge.

One thing I found interesting about this particular car is the offset seating arrangement. You will notice in the photos the passenger seat was set back from the drivers position. I'm not sure why they did this, maybe so the passenger would not interfere with the driver while shifting or steering.

I find these 30's car's fascinating. They were the "super" cars of their time when paved roads were not commonplace and yet are capable of freeway speeds today.

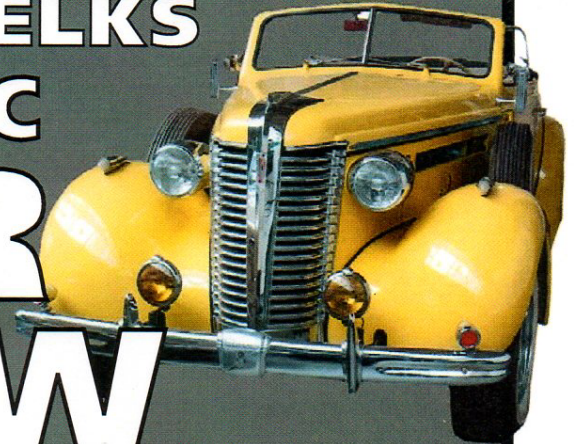
