Used primarily during the Korean and Vietnam wars as a trainer/low level attack aircraft.



# The bi-plane is a North American PT17 Used as a trainer during WWII. Many ended their military service to become crop dusters or for amusement rides around the country.



This WWII war plane is a North America P51D Mustang.
Premiere fighter that dominated the skies over Europe.
This example was likely built at their factory in Southern California and featured a Rolls Royce designed supercharged V12 built under license by Packard Motor Company.
