- Drive to a destination with a stop for a meal

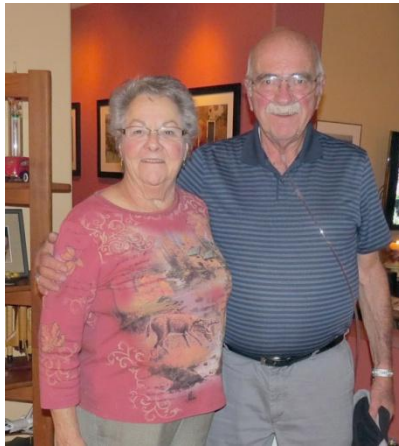
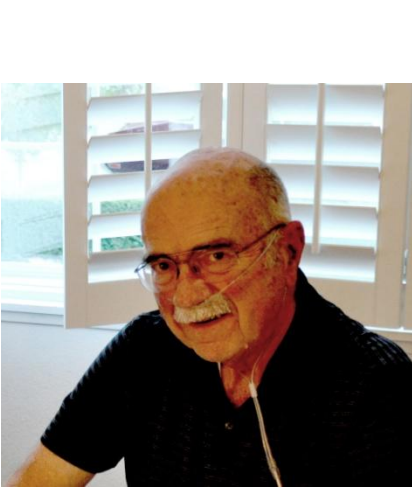
- Donation to a local school's Auto Shop – Maria Carrillo High School and Petaluma High School both have Auto Shops

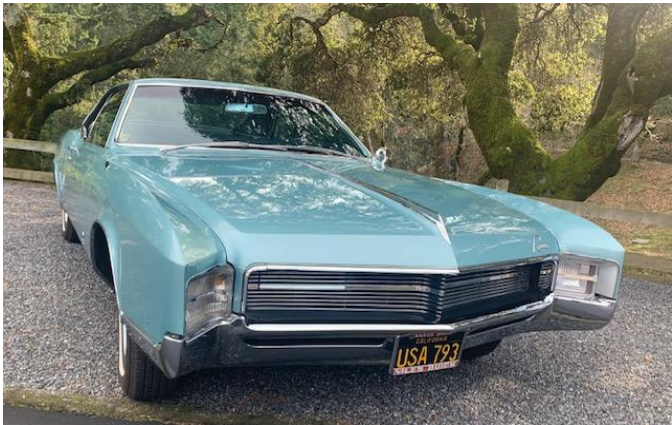
