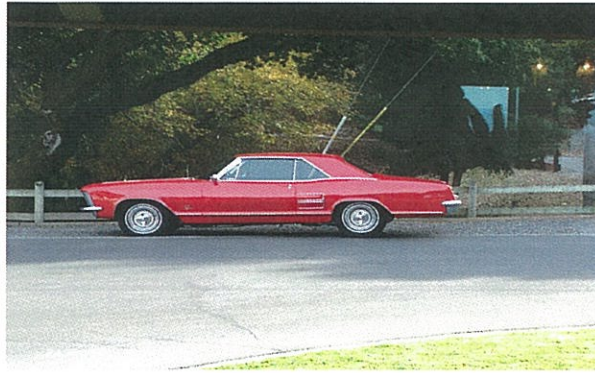

MINUTES OF THE DECEMBER 10TH, 2014 MEETING

Members in attendance were Don and Lois Brooner, Keith Brumbley, Bill and Joan Costello, Terry Eggleston, Rich and April Kahnberg, Kenny Silvestri, and Stan Sollid.

April introduced our guests to the membership. Vickie Fertig and Frank Moraes were both former members.

At 6:55 p.m. Rich called the meeting to order.

Rich passed out notes of the November meeting taken by April for review by the membership. A later vote will be taken for approval.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Rich reported the current bank balance. Deposits for the month were from November's raffle and dues. Membership dues are due on January 1, 2015. Rich has sent out reminders to all members. There have been 11 renewals to date with 10 members who have not renewed. Rich will send out a second reminder. Joe Rosendahl and Mike & Connie Lightell will not be rejoining and will be missed by all. Vickie Fertig rejoined the club this evening. Welcome back, Vickie.

OLD BUSINESS

Keith reported on the subject of toppers for license plates or grilles. The price he quoted at November's meeting did not include tax and shipping for orders placed in the U.S. only the order coming from China. April offered members a cost and material breakdown for the three sources of toppers – China, Indiana or North Dakota. Rich will send out an e-mail to members asking how many each member would like to order pre-paid. We would need 50 toppers to be pre-paid before we place an order. Discussion followed regarding the three sources of toppers. Bill made a motion for Rich to send out a query to members with prices quoted from China which was the least expensive quote. Motion was seconded by Rich. No action will be taken, however, until more discussion at the January meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

Since the November meeting, three members have resigned from office: Keith Brumbley as Director and co-Newsletter Editor, Rebecca Kisling as Secretary and co-Newsletter Editor, and David Yoast as Assistant Director. Nominations were open for the vacant offices. April Kahnberg was nominated by Joan for Director. The motion was seconded by Bill. Kenny Silvestri was nominated by Bill for Assistant Director. Lois seconded the motion. Joan Costello was nominated by April for the position of Secretary. The motion was seconded by Bill. All nominated members accepted the nominations. Don made a motion to accept the slate of officers. Motion was seconded by Bill and passed by majority vote. The offices of Treasurer and Webmaster will not change.

Rich and April volunteered to temporarily take the office of Newsletter Editor. They will create a format for the newsletter and continue for a few months with the hopes that someone will take over the responsibility. Terry said he would like the newsletter submitted to him a week before the meeting to give him time to put it on the website so members can receive it before the meeting. Members who have articles they would like in the newsletter should e-mail them to Rich or April.

Newly elected Director, April, suggested that the current job descriptions and bylaws be reviewed in the near future. April also asked that members e-mail her any annual car shows or events which will then be written on a calendar for the entire year.

Discussion followed regarding the minutes for each meeting. It was agreed that Joan will send a draft of the minutes to members present at the meeting. Members will be asked to read the minutes and reply to Joan with any additions or corrections. Joan will then submit the corrected minutes for publication in the newsletter.

Rich contacted the Exchange Bank in Rohnert Park to learn the procedure to have our new officers become signees for club checks. All checks are required to have two authorized signatures. April declined as a signee since she is the wife of the club Treasurer. The officers who will be added as signees will be Terry (Webmaster), Kenny (Assistant Director) and Joan (Secretary). Rich (Treasurer) will remain as an authorized signee.

In the near future, Rich would like to look into the possibility of moving our post office box from Rohnert Park to Santa Rosa.

Rich made a motion to accept the minutes from the November meeting. Bill seconded the motion and it passed by majority vote.

Terry asked the club members if they would be interested in displaying their cars at the Sonoma County Air Show. Concerns were brought up about people opening car doors and sitting inside. Members agreed that we would not participate.

Rich has a Christmas card for Jack and Juanita Wilson (former members who moved), Joe Rosendahl and Rusty Tucker that members can sign at the Christmas Party which is Saturday at 4:00 at the Kahnberg's.

Rich went around the room asking what was going on with each of our members.

Raffle followed with Rich winning the 50/50 prize of \$19.00.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m.

In addition to our hosts, Don and Lois, Bill and Joan, Stan and Gail, Kenny, Keith, and Terry and Michelle attended.

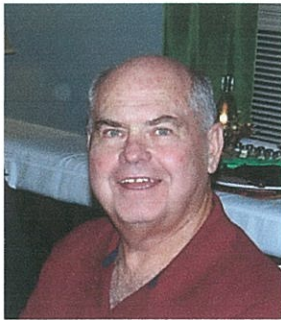

Lois Brooner's Yummy Lemon Squares

LEMON SQUARES...

crust

1 cup flour

1/2 cup butter

1/4 cup powdered sugar.

Prepare like pie crust and pat into 8x8" pan.

Bake 20 minutes @350 degrees.

Beat 2 eggs

1 cup sugar

...add dash of salt

3 tablespoons lemon juice.

Mix well.

Combine

2 tablespoons flour

1/2 teaspoon baking powder

Add to egg mixture, mixing well.

Pour into prepared crust and bake 25 minutes.

Cut while warm and sprinkle with powdered sugar. **Let cool well before serving.**
