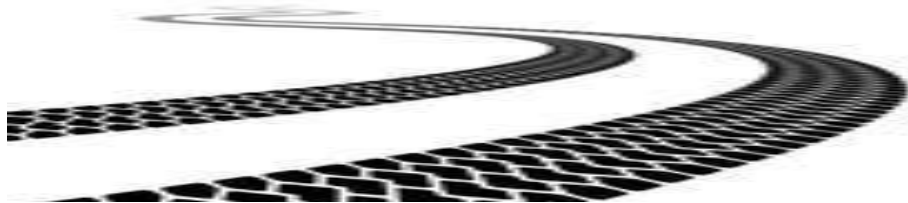
# PROGRESSIVE (pot luck) DINNER
